**Florian Streich**, cello, studied in Cologne, in The Hague/ Netherlands and with M. Sanderling and A. Merkle in Frankfurt am Main, Germany. Peter Bruns, Claudio Bohórquez, Menahem Pressler and members of the Mandelring-the Alban Berg- and the Fauré Quartett, to name but a few, gave him further musical insight. He won a great number of international prizes, plays concerts all around Europe and holds a teaching position at the Royal Northern College of Music, Manchester, UK. Florian Streich plays a Testore cello from 1745, kindly provided to him by the Hoenes Stiftung - Museum Villa Rot.

**Sarah Hiller**, piano, began studying with Fany Solter at the HfM in Karlsruhe, where she passed her Diploma, Master of Music and soloist examination all with distinction. She holds many national and international prizes and has played solo and chamber music recitals in many countries and recorded with WDR, SWR and Deutschlandradio Kultur. She played in Festivals and concert series like the Schwetzingen Festival, the Rheingau Festival and N.Y Chamber Music Festival. In 2009 she was awarded an Erasmus bursary to study with Homero Francesch. From 2010 she studied Chamber Music at the HfMDK in Frankfurt with Angelika Merkle, where she now holds a part-time lectureship.
