



Why Use iPad2 Tablets


- Access to authentic and up-to date materials
- Student-driven content
- Enhances collaborative learning and teaching
- Portable language learning tool: portable media player, mini computer, portable storage device
- Thousands of free applications called "Apps" (some must be bought for a buck or 2)
- A familiar medium used on a daily basis
- User interface comes in at least 30 languages, including Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Russian, and Spanish



Why Use iPad2 Tablets

- Language study programs
- Dictionaries in Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Spanish, etc.
- On-line language dictionaries
- Multimedial: Audio & Video, Images, Graphs, Text
- Instant results:
 - ★ Access to Internet sites in the target language
 - ★ Audio and video files readily available to be viewed
 - * Research on the Internet
 - ★ Listening to lectures and the news
 - ★ Calculator: Convert US measures (feet, miles, gallons, Fahrenheit, etc.) into metric system and vice versa





iPad2 and Language Learning


- Immersion in the language through:
 - ★ Listening to songs & reading the lyrics
 - ★ Subscribing to, downloading and watching podcasts through iTunes (news, videos, cultural programs, etc.)
 - ★ Accessing on-line dictionaries or down-loading them onto the iPod Touch
 - ★ Virtual journeys: <u>iLingo</u> (\$9.99) translator with local city guides and cultural notes, tours of tourist sites, e.g. Versailles, or about various artists (SFMOMA Artcasts in the iTunes Store), <u>iSubwayMaps</u> or GoogleMaps from Cairo, Shanghai, Beijing, etc.
 - ★ Free foreign language lessons, audio books, and more on the Open Culture website
