## **KERBY'S QUICK LIST OF CHILDREN'S AUTHORS**

This list gives an overview of current children's literature—authors and illustrators respected by reviewers and loved by children. I've not listed many Newbery and Caldecott winners since I've given you those lists. When I highlight authors in class, you may expect to see them on a test.

Your task is to get a book by each author as a way to help you find the authors **YOU** like. When you do not like a particular book, skim it and go on to something else. Do not write an annotation for this book. When you find an author you really enjoy, read more of his/her books.

In addition to the Quick List, you must also select books from the **current year's master lists of the: (1) ALA/ALSC** <u>Notable Lists</u> (these include books, recordings, videos, and software; (2) ALA/ALSC current year's Newbery honor and Caldecott honor books, **the Pura Belpré, Coretta Scott King, Sibert, and Geisel Award** books; (3) newest list of Outstanding Science Trade Books; (4) newest list of Outstanding Books in the Field of Social Studies; (5) IBBY Honour List 2010 at <u>http://www.ibby.org</u>; (6) USBBY list at <u>http://www.usbby.org/2010 USBBY-OIB Bookmark.pdf</u>, and (7) the Maryland Black-Eyed Susan Award books and/or Pennsylvania Young Reader's Choice Award books—either titles that have won the award or titles that are on the current lists. Select titles that you will enjoy.

You should also use the sources listed in the syllabus to select good books. Read books for diverse learners related to: ethnicity, race, gender, language, socioeconomic status, disability, geographical area, religious background, and exceptionalities in learning. These types of books should also appear on your bibliography.
